We pray all with grateful hearts in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.









The retreat was amazing. Twenty people gathered on a Saturday in September at Camp Gray to come to



know and love God more. They laughed at silly skits and songs. Their small groups were fun and gave each person a chance to learn at their own pace. Activity time was an opportunity to play outside, make a craft, or just sit and talk with new friends.

God was very present throughout the day. Msgr. Larry celebrated Mass at 3pm, and the group was blessed to hear the readings proclaimed by two people with disabilities who had never read at Mass before. After Mass, the group entered into a time of

quiet prayer which many people agreed was the best part of the retreat. Participants said they could really feel God was there with them in a way they had never felt before.



Throughout the day, the group learned that Jesus is the Good Shepherd. He knows each person by name



and lovingly cares for them. When we come back to Him, He scoops us up and carries us. We can always trust in Him because He knows and loves each of us like a good shepherd knows his sheep.


