Mass Intentions

There is a long tradition in the Catholic Church for people to request a particular intention for a celebrated Holy Mass. The Apostolate currently has hundreds of such requests that we are striving to honor. Because the TV Mass is celebrated fifty-two(52) Sundays each year, it is difficult to fulfill all of these requests. Priests throughout the Diocese of Madison can request Mass intentions either for their parish or for their personal celebration of Masses, which enables us to fulfill some of the surplus intentions we currently have.

For these reasons, we are asking you to consider giving a Memorial Donation to the Apostolate in memory of a loved one instead of requesting Mass Intentions. We understand the importance of the distinction between having a Mass offered for their soul and a donation in memory of them, so we would encourage you to contact your local pastorate churches to have Masses said. The Apostolate will continue to accept Mass intention requests for specific TV Mass dates with the same policy in place that each person is able to request one TV Mass per year. We will also still accept Mass Intention requests, we are asking that you consider the options above before sending us more. Thank you!

The Diocese of Madison has just entered into the next phase of it's Into the Deep initiative with the formation of 30 new Pastorates. Some of these Pastorates already have one or more Disability and/or Mental Health Ministries, while others have not yet established either ministry in any churches that are part of their Pastorate. As the Apostolate for Persons with Disabilities, we see this transition as a great opportunity for disability and mental health ministries to join forces to better serve the needs of the new Pastorate as a whole, for those in places that haven't previously had a ministry, but now are part of a Pastorate with one, to connect with that ministry, and for individuals to consider being a Disability Liaison or Mental Health Advocate for the Apostolate so that we can establish each of these ministries in all 30 Pastorates and better serve the needs to those with disabilities and mental health challenges across the Diocese of Madison. To find out if there is an established ministry in your Pastorate, we would encourage you to connect with your new Parochial Administrator or you can call/email the Apostolate for Persons with Disabilities office and request information about your Pastorate's ministries.

We know that transition and change can be difficult and come with some anxieties and worries. We want everyone in our community to know that we are here to support the Pastorates and individuals across the diocese by providing resources, training, materials, etc so that all people are able to be included and active participants in the life of the Catholic Church in the Diocese of Madison.
